OVERVIEW

Since 2007 the Scottish Funding Council (SFC) has funded six designated Articulation Hubs. The hubs were established to increase the numbers of students articulating – entering university with advanced standing after studying for an HN at college. The aim of the hubs is to support a properly planned system of articulation focusing on specific areas such as curriculum mapping; establishment of new routes; transitional support; enhanced student experience and improved data capture and tracking.

The fourth annual Articulation for All Conference provides an opportunity to share experiences. Examples of good practice will be showcased and areas of development will be highlighted in workshops.
